

WATER AND WASTEWATER SECTOR THREAT BRIEFING



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Water Infrastructure and Cyber Resilience Division (WICRD), in partnership with the Water Information Sharing and Analysis Center (WaterISAC), Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), and Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Office of Intelligence & Analysis (I&A), is offering a virtual threat briefing that will be held on February 27, 2025.
